

OPTIONAL HALF DAY: Visit during one of the many annual waterfront festivals such as the Gullah Christmas holiday weekend in December, Gullah Festival in May, Water Festival in July, Lands End Festival in September or Shrimp Festival in October when culinary delights entice while live entertainment and craft markets keep guests busy.

**HALF DAY**: Visit the **Penn Center** Historic District, which includes **Brick Baptist Church**, The **York W**. **Bailey Museum** and other historic buildings on the campus observing its 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary. View the nearby ruins of **Chapel of Ease** and historic **Fort Freemont**.
