9:30 – 11:30: Free time to shop and explore **Historic Downtown Greenwood** where many of the city's downtown buildings are listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

11:30 – 1:00: Lunch and Learn at Viking Cooking School where students enjoy demonstration lessons from expert instructors and notable chefs in a complete Viking kitchen

1:00 – 2:00: The Help Driving Tour – On May 13, 2010, DreamWorks Studios formally announced that a major motion picture based on Mississippi native Kathryn Stockett's bestselling novel *The Help* would be filmed in Greenwood, Mississippi.
