- Catch an outdoor park performance of the Sioux Falls Municipal Band May thru August.
- Take a tour of the **Pettigrew Home & Museum**. Free guided tours every hour.
- Learn about Sioux Falls history at the Sound & Light Show Falls Park (Memorial Day thru Labor Day).
- Explore the newly expanded USS Battleship Museum.
- Capture a breath taking view from the Falls Park Five Story Viewing Tower.
- Learn about the local history at Center for Western Studies Exhibits.
- Take a **Community Wonders Tour** of the art and sculptures throughout the city.
- Jump on the **Trolley** and take in the sites of Downtown Sioux Falls.
- Visit the Horse Barn Arts Center and view area artists work.
- Spread out the blanket and enjoy the music of JazzFest annually in July.
- Make **SculptureWalk** part of a scavenger hunt.
- Take in the music at **Automania** event while you peruse the classic automobiles.
- Explore the Visual Arts Center at the Washington Pavilion . . most exhibits are free.
- Visit the exhibits at the Old Courthouse Museum.
- Capture some family time and enjoy Moonlight Movies on Saturday evenings in Fawick Park.
- Enjoy getting back in touch with nature at The Outdoor Campus.
- Great Plains Balloon Race annually in June.
- The Earth Resources Observation and Science (**EROS**) Center offers on-site guided tours are available Monday through Friday at 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m.
- First Fridays of every month the Kirby Science Discover Center at the Washington Pavilion is FREE and open to the public from 5pm-8pm.
- Old Courthouse Museum Friday concert series on your lunch break during the summer.
- Enjoy the exotic flowers trees, pagodas and lanterns of the Shoto-Teien Japanese Gardens near Covell Lake.
- **Lifelight Christian Music Festival** is one of the nation's largest FREE Christian music festival. It attracts dozens of leading Christian artists performing on five stages over three days annually Labor Day weekend.
- See medical advancements from the early 1900's to the present at the **Sioux Empire Medical Museum** on Sanford Health Campus.
- The **Museum of Visual Materials** is the one of the oldest building in Downtown Sioux Falls, South Dakota (1887) but is one of the city's newest museums. It's so different; you might forget you're in a museum!
- Visit **Veteran's Memorial Park** which honors the military history of our community and allows for a place to reflect on the sacrifices that all veterans have made.
